



PEER™ Supervision Training, 2010

This is a training for those who have completed PEER I, II & III and are interested in more in-depth training and supervision in facilitating emotional release work using PEER™ techniques. The training will consist of approximately 35 hours of intensive education, exercise and practice.

By participating in the group, you can expect to:

- Increase your understanding of how and why PEER™ works.
- Become more comfortable using basic PEER™ techniques (i.e., using pillows, finger squeezing, towel twist, pushing, using the blocker/bataka, etc.)
- Be more able to follow your clients' or others' energy through body reading, facial expression and tracking clients' use of language.
- Become aware of the ways your own issues help and hinder you as a facilitator, and develop a strategy for *getting out of your own way*.

PEER Supervision offers you a chance to explore and develop your PEER skills at a deeper and more personal level than is possible in the larger trainings. You will participate in exercises that will help you develop specific skills as well as doing your own work and facilitating others while receiving supervision.

The training will take place in Montreat, North Carolina (near Asheville) over two three-day residential weekends, **Feb. 19-21 and April 16-18, 2010**. It will begin at 9am on Fri. morning and conclude about 2pm on the Sunday of each weekend. Rooms will be available Thursday evening (Feb 18 and April 15). Prices are based on double occupancy but some private rooms will be available, first come, first served. The cost for the entire training, including room and board and the 75 page PEER™ Training Manual, is \$1395., or \$1250. for meals only, commuters. If you plan to attend, send a deposit of \$700. by Jan. 11, 2010 to: The Innerlight Center, PO Box 970, Black Mountain, NC 28711. This deposit is non-refundable. We will try to work out payment schedules if needed. **Note: at this time, this Training is not scheduled to be offered again!** There is an application process, so please let us know ASAP if you are interested in attending.
